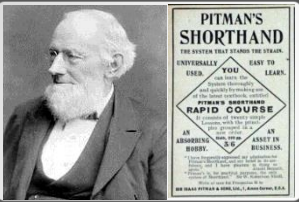


Distance Education Timeline
